MAIDSTONE, ONTARIO, CANADA BOUVIER DES FLANDRES WINS HERDING GROUP AT 143RD ANNUAL WESTMINSTER KENNEL CLUB DOG SHOW IN NEW YORK CITY

New York, NY – The Bouvier des Flandres "Baby Lars" of Maidstone, Ontario, Canada, handled by breeder and owner Elaine Paquette for co-owners Julianna Garrison and Louise Paquette, won the Herding Group under Judge Peggy Beisel-McIlwaine at the 143rd Annual Westminster Kennel Club Dog Show in New York City on Monday and Tuesday, February 11-12, 2019.

Baby Lars, a 6-year-old male, officially known as GCHS Quiche's Major League, bred by Elaine and Louise Paquette, took top honors in a field of 30 Best of Breed winners entered, comprising the Herding Group. This Bouvier is the fourth of its breed to win the Herding group at Westminster. Westminster reached its conformation entry limit of 2,800 dogs, with two days of Best of Breed competition held at Piers 92/94 and Group and Best in Show competitions held at Madison Square Garden.

"Winning a Westminster Group is the culmination of years of hard work, breeding, showing, training, and conditioning. Congratulations to Baby Lars' team," said Westminster Kennel Club Director of Communications Gail Miller Bisher.
