Mrs. Collier has been involved in the sport of dogs since 1968 as a breeder and exhibitor of Old English Sheepdogs, Doberman Pinschers and Komondorok. Her Summithill kennels is known for producing many champions and best in show winning Komondorok. She became a licensed judge in the early 1980's and now judges the Working and Herding groups in the U.S. and abroad. Mrs. Collier has a long history with the Westminster Kennel Club as a judge officiating 14 times including the best in show competition in 1997. Her late husband Mr. Chet Collier was the club president from 1989 - 2001 and was instrumental in creating the popular television show of the group and best in show competitions live from Madison Square Garden.

In addition to her judging, Mrs. Collier is also a founding member of the non-profit, Take the Lead organization. This organization, established in 1993, provides direct services, support and care for people in the sport of purebred dogs who suffer the devastation of life-threatening or terminal illness.
