## BIXBY, OKLAHOMA FRENCH BULLDOG WINS NON-SPORTING GROUP AT THE 146<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL WESTMINSTER KENNEL CLUB DOG SHOW

**New York, NY** — The French Bulldog of Bixby, OK, handled by Perry Payson, owned by Sandy Fox, Morgan Fox, Perry Payson and Alexandra Vorbeck, and bred by Sandy Fox and Perry Payson, won the Non-Sporting Group under judge Ms. Evalyn Gregory at the 146<sup>th</sup> Annual Westminster Kennel Club Dog Show presented by Purina Pro Plan held at the Lyndhurst Estate in Tarrytown, New York on Tuesday, June 21, 2022.

Winston, a 3.5-year-old male, officially known as GCHP CH Fox Canyon's I Won The War At Goldshield CGCA CGCU TKN, took top honors among the 321 dogs entered within the Non-Sporting Group. Westminster saw over 3,000 entries in conformation, with three days of Best of Breed judging from June 20-22, culminating with the Group and Best in Show competitions.
