## NORTHAMPTON, PENNSYLVANIA STANDARD POODLE WINS NON-SPORTING GROUP AT 144<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL WESTMINSTER KENNEL CLUB DOG SHOW IN NEW YORK CITY

**NEW YORK** – The Standard Poodle "Siba" of Northampton, Pennsylvania, handled by Chrystal Clas for owners Connie Unger and William Lee, won the Non-Sporting Group under Judge Allen Odom at the 144<sup>th</sup> Annual Westminster Kennel Club Dog Show in New York City on February 10, 2020.

Siba, a 4-year-old female, officially known as GCHP Stone Run Afternoon Tea, bred by Connie Unger, took top honors in a field of 21 Best of Breed winners entered, comprising the Non-Sporting Group. Westminster reached its conformation entry limit of 2,500 dogs, with three days of Best of Breed competition on Feb. 9-11 held at Pier 94, and Group and Best in Show competition held at Madison Square Garden.

"Winning the Non-Sporting Group at the Garden is an impressive achievement," said Westminster Kennel Club Director of Communications Gail Miller Bisher. "Congratulations to Siba and her devoted breeder, owners, and handler."
